Dr. Moyer and Dr. Caine both encourages AMS and students to attend the NMA National conference in Orlando, FL. Held August 11-15, 2018. Unfortunately, for the students, they will be back in school or in the middle of their third year rotations.

The floor was open for Questions from the students to the doctors. First, a few questions were posed from those who submitted questions ahead of time. Questions on incorporating research during medical school and beyond, Clinical

The Aesculapian Medical Society had a small business meeting where two things were discussed and voted on.

1. Voted and Approved to sponsor the IUSM SNMA up to \$3,000 for this year coming to a close. Additionally, Dr. Joyce Gill volunteered to follow through on her pledge to support one of the IUSM SNMA meetings, so a total of \$3,250 will be sent to the IUSM SNMA to distribute as they see fit.
2. Voted and Approved a pledge of \$10,000 (\$2,000 each year for 5 years) toward the IUSM Diversity Recruitment Scholarship.
